WHY STUDY HAITIAN AT KU?

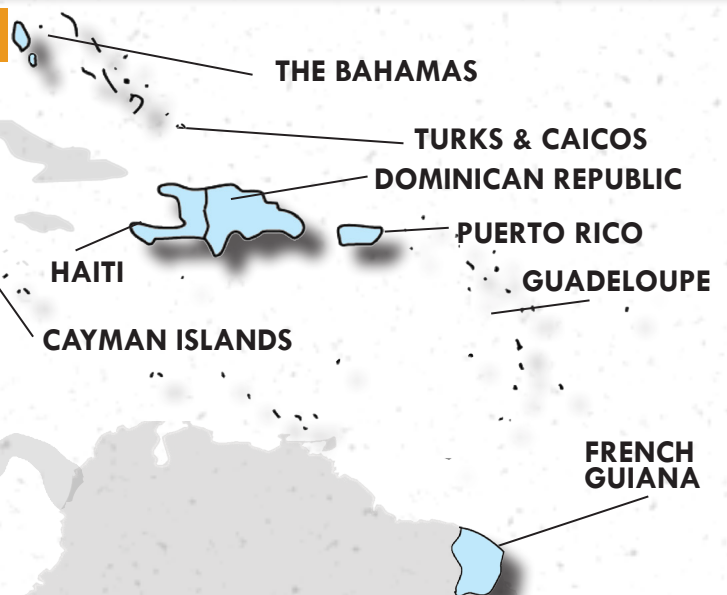
- Qualify for FLAS Fellowships: \$15,000-\$33,000/year; \$7,500/summer
