AAAS 102: Introduction to Islam (3 HRS) ONLINE Winter Session Ghazali
An introduction to the study of Islam and the Arabic language in relation to Islamic cultures in Africa, the Mediterranean region, and beyond. Topics covered include the historical origins of Islam in relation to the Arabic language and its cultures of origin. This course is interdisciplinary, including attention to the topic from the perspectives of historical unfolding of both the language and religion, geographic and cultural perspectives, political and economic concerns, and aesthetic perspectives, including literature and the arts. AAAS 104: Intro to African History (3 HRS) ONLINE Winter Session Kastor
Interdisciplinary introduction to the basic concepts and literature in the disciplines covered in African American Studies. Includes the social sciences, and humanities (including history, religion, and literature) as well as conceptual framework for investigation and analysis of Black history and culture and society. LEC. (3 / AE41 / SC / U)

AAAS 105: Intro to African-American Studies (3 HRS) ONLINE Winter Session Kastor
An introduction to important historical developments in Africa. Topics include empires, kingdoms, the slave trade, European colonialism, liberation movements, national identities, and a return to independence. (Same as HIST 104.). LEC. (3 / GE11 / GE3H / H / NW / W)
